**\* Criteria for inclusion in official meeting log:**

We include all scheduled policy discussions with NGOs, charities, businesses and other lobby groups, as well as meetings where substantial lobbying and discussions of future work take place at Parliamentary events and drop-ins.

We exclude appearances at public meetings hosted by these groups and meetings in Parliament that are open to the public, as well as meetings between MPs and other elected representatives.

We exclude casework and surgery meetings, and constituent lobbies unless these are with local or national campaign group representatives acting collectively.

We exclude meetings with journalists and with people raising issues of public interest on whistleblower terms.
